National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) Application for Foreign Pharmacy Graduate Examination Committee (FPGEC) Certification



Submit to NABP:

- Educational Equivalency Documentation
- License/registration verification



Examinations

- **Foreign Pharmacy Graduate Equivalency Examination (FPGEE)**
 - You may not take the FPGEE until your education and licensure and/or registration have been reviewed and approved.
- **TOEFL iBT**
 - You may take the TOEFL iBT at any time in the process

Pharmacy Internship

- Ohio State Board of Pharmacy Application for Pharmacy Internship
- Criminal Records Check
 - Submit request to Bureau of Identification and Investigation (BCI&I)
- Complete 1,500 hours of Pharmacy Internship



Ohio State Board of Pharmacy Licensure Exams

- Ohio State Board of Pharmacy Application for Examination
- NABP Application for NAPLEX/MPJE
- Criminal Records Check

- North American Pharmacy Licensure Examination (NAPLEX)
- Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination (MPJE, not transferrable)
