REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

ANTIOCH COLLEGE

Institutional Reauthorization

Request:

Antioch College requests continued authorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents.

Profile and Accreditation/Authorization:

Antioch College, located in Yellow Springs, Ohio, was originally established in 1852 and later reincorporated as Antioch University in 1978. The college was originally authorized by the Chancellor in January 1970 and had been regionally accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (HLC). The college closed in June 2008 and reopened in fall 2011 as a newly constituted entity independent of Antioch University.

Program Offerings:

Antioch College offers Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science degrees.

Institutional Changes:

Since the college's last review for initial authorization as a newly constituted entity, the institution has attained candidacy status with the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

Recommendation to the Chancellor:

Antioch College meets the Chancellor's standards and the staff recommends continued institutional authorization through December 31, 2017 to coincide with the institution's next HLC review. The Chancellor may, in his judgment, withdraw authorization or require additional review if the institution fails to continue to meet the Chancellor's standards for authorization or fails to continue to progress towards full HLC accreditation.
