Allegheny Wesleyan College Institutional Reauthorization

Request:

Allegheny Wesleyan College requests reauthorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents.

Profile:

Allegheny Wesleyan College, located in Salem, Ohio, provides Biblical education based on the conservative Wesleyan tradition.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Allegheny Wesleyan College is nationally accredited by the Association for Biblical Higher Education (ABHE). The institution has been previously authorized by the Chancellor and requests continuation of that authorization.

Program Offerings:

Allegheny Wesleyan College offers Bachelor of Arts degrees in Music Ministry, Elementary Education, Cross-Cultural Missions, Religious Studies and Pastoral Ministries. The college also offers an Associate of Arts in General Studies.

Institutional Changes:


Allegheny Wesleyan College was first authorized by the Chancellor in 1986. In 2013, the college requested exemption from authorization. Soon after the request, a new president was appointed to the college. That president withdrew the exemption request and has been working with the Ohio Board of Regents staff ensure that the Chancellor's standards are in place at Allegheny Wesleyan College.

Recommendation to the Chancellor:

Allegheny Wesleyan College meets the Chancellor's standards for Bachelor of Arts programs. The review team recommends continuous authorization through 2019 contingent upon annual progress reports from the college. Progress reports are due September 30, 2015, June 30, 2016, June 30, 2017 and June 30, 2018. Reauthorization will coincide with the college's reauthorization in 2019 with the Commission on Accreditation of the Association for Biblical Higher Education.
