Institutional Reauthorization

Request:

American College of Education (ACE) requests continued authorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents for the Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction, the Master of Education in Educational Leadership and the Master of Education in Educational Technology.

Profile:

American College of Education, located in Indianapolis, Indiana, is a for-profit online institution offering certificates, masters, specialist and doctoral degrees in education for teachers, administrators and other professionals working in educational settings.

Accreditation/Authorization:

American College of Education is regionally accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of the North Central Association until its next scheduled review in 2015. American College of Education's educator preparation programs were accredited at the graduate levels by the Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC) through spring 2020.

Program Offerings:

American College of Education offers online graduate degrees in education. ACE requests continuing authorization to offer the Master of Education in Educational Technology, the Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction. The Master of Education in Leadership is the only program that leads to Ohio licensure; the program currently under continuing review in the spring 2015 review cycle.

Institutional Changes:

American College of Education has had changes in the presidency since its last reauthorization.


Recommendation to the Chancellor:

American College of Education meets the Chancellor's standards and the staff recommends continued institutional authorization contingent upon the result of American College of Education's next reaffirmation with the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association and the Teacher Education Accreditation Council. The Chancellor may, in his judgment, withdraw authorization or require additional review if the college fails to continue to meet the Chancellor's standards for authorization or is sanctioned by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association.


