### REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

#### Bowling Green State University Master of Music Education, Teaching Artistry Specialization

##### **Request:**

The College of Musical Arts at Bowling Green State University requests approval for a new specialization in Teaching Artistry within the existing Master of Music Education degree.

##### **Background:**

Bowling Green State University is a public university with a main campus location in Bowling Green and a regional campus in Huron, Ohio. The university is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC). The new proposed specialization is designed for professionally practicing music instructors who already possess a bachelor's degree in music, and who do not intend to pursue a terminal degree. It is a non-licensure program.

##### **Curriculum and Enrollment:**

The proposed specialization requires a minimum of 30 semester credit hours, with a four credit hour component which will take place during the academic year. The proposed program provides a non-thesis option, with final oral examinations and a research project relevant to the student's teaching position. An initial cohort of 20 students is expected.

##### **Faculty and Resources:**

Qualified faculty and adequate facilities and resources are in place to begin the program. As cohort sizes increase, revenue from the degree will be directed back into the department to support additional faculty and staff resources.

##### **Recommendation:**

The proposed new Teaching Artistry specialization within the existing Master of Music Education meets the Chancellor's standards for graduate degrees, and the Regents' Advisory Committee on Graduate Study voted unanimously to recommend approval to the Chancellor.
