#### CLEVELAND INSTITUTE OF ART

##### Institutional Reauthorization

**Request:**

Cleveland Institute of Art requests continued authorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents.

**Profile:**

Cleveland Institute of Art, located in Cleveland, Ohio, is an independent non-profit institution. Originally established in 1882, the institution today serves over 500 students and offers fifteen undergraduate majors specializing in visual arts education.

**Accreditation/Authorization:**

Cleveland Institute of Art is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (HLC) and possesses specialized accreditation from the National Association of Schools of Art and Design. The institution has been authorized by the Chancellor since February 1970.

**Program Offerings:**

Cleveland Institute of Art is authorized to offer a Bachelor of Fine Arts.

**Institutional Changes:**

Since its last institutional reauthorization review, Cleveland Institute of Art experienced a change in the presidency and expanded/discontinued program offerings to better meet institutional and student needs.


**Recommendation to the Chancellor:**

Cleveland Institute of Art meets the Chancellor's standards and the staff recommends continued institutional authorization through December 31, 2022 to coincide with the institution's next accreditation reaffirmation review with the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The Chancellor may, in his judgment, withdraw authorization or require additional review if the institutions fail to continue to meet the Chancellor's standards for authorization or is sanctioned by HLC.

The Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs has verified that this institution has met the standards and requirements of the Ohio Board of Regents.


