REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

CLEVELAND STATE UNIVERSITY Master of Education in Health Professions Education

Request:

Cleveland State University requests approval to offer a Master of Education in Health Professions Education.

Background:

The Master of Education in Health Professions Education is a professional degree designed for physicians, nurses, health and clinical educators, and other health sciences professionals. The mission of the program is to "impart the knowledge, skills and behaviors incumbent in effective teaching, administration and leadership to students who desire advanced training in medical education."

Curriculum and Enrollment:

The program, composed of thirty semester credit hours, may be completed in two-years and will be offered on campus, online, and within off-campus clinical and medical settings. The curriculum, developed collaboratively with the Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine, includes coursework in the psychology of adult learning, instructional principles for adult learners, educational research, statistics for health sciences, and program planning and evaluation. Students will complete a final project that focuses on research, program or curriculum development, or evaluation methods in health professions education.

The university anticipates an initial enrollment of 15-20 students to begin fall 2015, with subsequent cohorts to begin every other year.

Faculty and Resources:

Existing faculty and resources are in place to begin the program. The university intends to hire additional faculty members as program enrollment grows.

Recommendation:

The program meets the Chancellor's standards for graduate degrees and the Regents' Advisory Committee on Graduate Study voted to recommend approval to the Chancellor.
