



REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

CLEVELAND STATE UNIVERSITY Master of Science in Health Care Management

Request:

Cleveland State University requests approval to offer the Master of Science in Health Care Management.

Background:

Cleveland State University is a public university founded in 1964. The university is located in Cleveland, Ohio. The university today serves over 12,000 undergraduate students and over 5,000 graduate/professional students. Cleveland State University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission until its next scheduled review in 2020-21.

Curriculum and Enrollment:

The Master of Science in Health Care Management is a 30-semester hour post-bachelor's program. The program is designed to provide graduate education to individuals interested in preparing for careers in the management of health care entities, such as hospitals and managed health care organizations. The program includes coursework in financial management for health care managers; managing people in health care entities; efficiency management in health care; medical care organization; analysis of health care markets; public health administration; seminar in health quality and policy; health care informatics for managers; health care law and ethics; and integrated business strategy for health care administration. The program culminates in a capstone experience.

The university projects an enrollment of 30 FTE in the first year increasing to 100 FTE in year-four.

Faculty and Resources:


Cleveland State University has adequately planned to deliver this program.

Recommendation:

After review of the proposal, the Chancellor's Council on Graduate Studies determined that the Master of Science in Health Care Management meets the Chancellor's standards for graduate degree programs and on November 19, 2021 voted 11 "Yes," and 0 "No" to recommend approval. Approval may be withdrawn if, in the Chancellor's judgement, the university fails to continue to meet the Chancellor's standards for graduate degree programs or receives a sanction from the Higher Learning Commission.
