



SECOND ADDENDUM TO DIRECTIVE 2011-023

July 6, 2017

RE: REORGANIZATION OF OH-TECH TO MOVE DIVISION OF ESTUDENT SERVICES TO BE PART OF OHIOLINK AND INTEGRATE THE CONFERENCE TEAM INTO CONSORTIA SERVICES.

On September 9, 2011, The Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents issued Directive 2011-023, directing, that the Ohio Supercomputer Center (OSC), the Ohio Academic Resources Network (OARnet), and the eStudent Services (eSS) be consolidated into one consortium to be known as the Ohio Technology Consortium (OH-TECH). On November 10, 2012, the Chancellor issued an Addendum to that Directive restructuring and consolidating OhioLINK to be part of OH-TECH.

With the continued focus of affordable textbooks and open education resources and the expanded role of libraries in these services to students, the synthesis of library and student service is paramount to the future successes of the both areas. Natural synergies already exist between libraries, tutoring, and distance-learning cataloging. Further connecting the administrative oversight of these activities will lead to future growth and continued successes.


Therefore, pursuant to division (T) of section 3333.04 of the Ohio Revised Code OH-TECH is hereby restructured to dissolve the eStudent Services division, and move its goals and responsibilities to be part of OhioLINK and report to the Director of OhioLINK.

Further, to continue to leverage existing resources and better align responsibilities and roles within OH-TECH, the Conference Team is moved to be part of the Consortia Services division. The Conference Team will continue to focus on conferences that focus on professional development in the education field, educational technology, distance learning and other education topics pertinent to the State of Ohio.

This amendment was posted to the Ohio Department of Higher Education's website for purposes of providing a period of public comment before final approval by the Chancellor. No public comments were received.

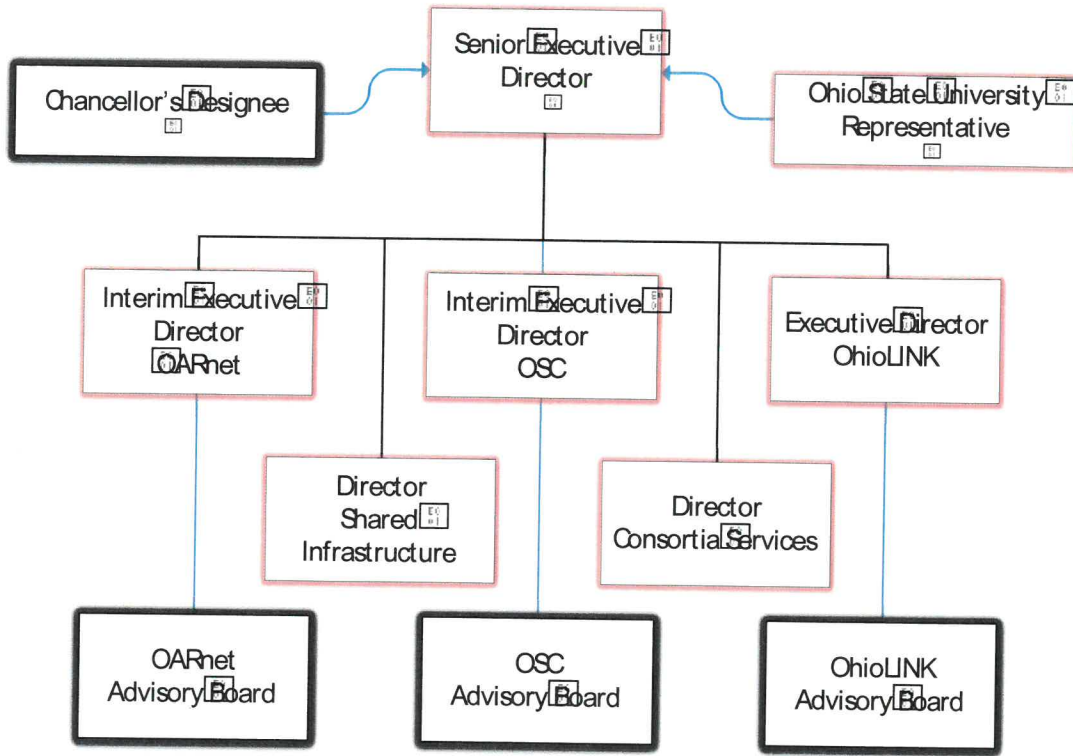
