



Re: Directive 2015-061

Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) has requested to modify its current tuition waiver, approved in Directive 2015-061, to charge the default floor in academic year 2016-2017 for nonpublic high school students that take courses at their high school taught by qualified teacher-adjuncts. The directive states that students will be charged \$40.00 per credit hour in academic year 2016-2017, but as the intent of the waiver was uniformity with College Credit Plus students, Tri-C charging such students the statutory default floor of \$41.50 per credit hour in academic year 2016-2017 is consistent with the current directive and does not require additional approval.
