



DIRECTIVE 2017-042 CORRECTED*

RE: JOINT USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN WRIGHT STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE
WRIGHT STATE RESEARCH INSTITUTE.

Wright State University has been granted appropriations contained in Senate Bills 260 and 310 of 131st General Assembly in the amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars and seven hundred fifty thousand dollars, respectfully. Wright State University will use the funds to improve the facility owned by the Wright State Research Institute. As required by Ohio Administrative Code section 3333-1-03, Wright State University submitted a Joint Use Agreement for consideration and approval by the Chancellor.


The agreement conforms to Ohio Administrative Code as follows –

- The format of the agreement is appropriate
- The commitment extends no less than twenty years
- The value of use to Ohio higher education institutions is reasonably related to the amount of the appropriation

Agency staff reviewed the agreement and posted its recommendations to the Department's website for the purpose of providing a period of public comment before final approval by the Chancellor. The materials posted for comment and the joint use agreement are attached to this document.

Based on my review of staff recommendations, I hereby approve the Joint Use Agreement between Wright State University and the Wright State Research Institute.

This directive will take effect immediately.
