EMBRY-RIDDLE AERONAUTICAL UNIVERSITY

Institutional Reauthorization

Request:

Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University requests continued authorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents.

Profile:

Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, administratively headquartered in Daytona Beach, Florida, is an independent, non-profit institution. Originally established in 1926 in Cincinnati, Ohio, the university today provides aviation/aerospace programs online and at numerous locations through the university's Worldwide Campus.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACS) until its next review in 2022. The institution has been authorized by the Chancellor since January 1989.

Program Offerings:

Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University offers the following programs online and at off-site locations in Cincinnati and Dayton, Ohio: Associate of Science, Bachelor of Science, and Master of Aeronautical Science.

Institutional Changes:

Since its last institutional reauthorization review, Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University expanded program site and delivery options in Ohio to better meet institutional and student needs.


Recommendation to the Chancellor:

Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University meets the Chancellor's standards and the staff recommends continued institutional authorization through December 31, 2023 to coincide with the institution's next accreditation reaffirmation review with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges. The Chancellor may, in his judgment, withdraw authorization or require additional review if the institutions fail to continue to meet the Chancellor's standards for authorization or is sanctioned by SACS.

The Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs has verified that this institution has met the standards and requirements of the Ohio Board of Regents.


