REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

Gallipolis Career College

Request:

Gallipolis Career College requests continued authorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents.

Background:

Gallipolis Career College is a co-educational, for-profit career college. The institution is accredited by the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools (ACICS) and recognized by the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools (SBCCS). The institution submitted its original request for authorization in response to HB 119 of the 127th General Assembly, which requires the Chancellor's authorization for associate degree programs in proprietary colleges and schools as a condition of their students' eligibility for OIG/OCOG funds, a state needs-based financial aid program. As a result of that initial review, Gallipolis Career College was granted provisional authorization until December 31, 2012, with a follow-up review to take place by December 31st to determine continued authorization.

Program Offerings:

Gallipolis Career College is requesting continued authorization by the Chancellor to offer the following programs:

Associate of Applied Business—Accounting

Associate of Applied Business—Business Administration

Associate of Applied Business—Computer Applications Technology

Associate of Applied Business—Executive Office Administration

Associate of Applied Business—Medical Office Administration

Associate of Applied Business—Technical Support Specialist

Review Results:

Gallipolis Career College successfully demonstrated compliance with the recommendations of the 2008 consultants' report through the submission of its initial institutional response, annual progress reports, and 2012 Focused Visit.


Institutional Changes:

Gallipolis Career College changed the name of two of its programs since its initial request to the Chancellor. The program name changes to Medical Office Administration (from Executive Office Administration with a Major in Medical Office Administration) and to Technical Support Specialist (from Computer Applications Technology with a Major in Technical Support Specialist) are noted above.

Recommendation to the Chancellor:

Gallipolis Career College meets the Chancellor's standards and the staff recommends continued authorization to coincide with the institution's current ACICS accreditation review cycle, which continues until December 31st of 2013. Authorization is contingent upon continuing accreditation from ACICS, continuing recognition from the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools and compliance with the Chancellor's standards. The Chancellor may, in his judgment, withdraw authorization or require additional review if the institution fails to continue to meet the Chancellor's standards for authorization or is sanctioned by ACICS or SBCCS.
