



REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

GOOD SAMARITAN COLLEGE OF NURSING AND HEALTH SCIENCE Institutional Reauthorization

Request:

Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Science requests continued authorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Department of Higher Education.

Background:

Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Science, located in Cincinnati, Ohio, is an independent institution affiliated with the Roman Catholic Church. Originally established in 1896 as a School of Nursing within the Good Samaritan Hospital, the college prepares nearly 400 undergraduate students for careers in nursing and allied health.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Science is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission through its next review in 2030-31. The college also possesses specialized accreditation from the Accrediting Commission for Education in Nursing until its next review in 2027. Good Samaritan College of Nursing has been authorized by the Chancellor since 1978.

Program Offerings:

Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Sciences offers the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing, Associate of Science in Health Science, and the Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

Institutional Changes:

Since its last reauthorization review, the Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Sciences has a new president and senior leadership, received Chancellor authorization for offering distance education, and implemented a new online learning management system.


Recommendation to the Chancellor:

After review of the proposal, the Chancellor's staff determined that Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Sciences meets the Chancellor's standards and recommends continued institutional authorization through December 31, 2031, to coincide with the next Higher Learning Commission reaffirmation of accreditation. The Chancellor may, in his judgment, withdraw authorization or require additional review if Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Sciences fails to meet the Chancellor's standards, receives a sanction from the Higher Learning Commission, or receives a sanction from the Accrediting Commission for Education in Nursing.
