Associate of Technical Study in Computer Information Technology

Request:

Lakeland Community College requests approval to offer an Associate of Technical Study (Type A) in Computer Information Technology.

Background:

Lakeland Community College serves nearly 21,000 students and offers more than fifty degree programs and ninety certificate programs. The mission of the college is to "provide quality learning opportunities to meet the social and economic needs of the community."

Curriculum and Enrollment:

The curriculum includes coursework in Internet technologies and concepts, programming logic, Network+, network essentials, Microsoft SQL concepts, Microsoft Access relational database, information technology project management, and computers and information processing.

Graduates of the program will find employment opportunities as information technology managers, computer support specialists, computer system analysts, network administrators, web developers, software engineers, and mobile application developers, with annual starting salaries ranging from \$38,000 to \$52,200.

The college is projecting an enrollment of twelve full-time students and thirty part-time students beginning fall 2014.

Faculty and Resources:

The college is financially prepared to offer the program. Existing faculty and resources are in place to begin the program.


Recommendation:

The program clearly meets the Chancellor's standards for associate degree programs. There were no concerns raised in the review.


