LINDSEY WILSON COLLEGE Institutional Reauthorization

Request:

Lindsey Wilson College requests continued authorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents.

Profile:

Lindsey Wilson College, located in Columbia, Kentucky, is a private, not-for-profit college affiliated with the United Methodist Church. The institution offers associate, baccalaureate, and master's programs.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Lindsey Wilson College is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges until its next scheduled review in 2023. The college has been authorized by the Chancellor since January 2009.

Program Offerings:

Lindsey Wilson College offers the Bachelor of Arts in Human Services and Counseling and the Master of Education in Counseling and Human Development in Ohio at Cincinnati State Community and Technical College and Southern State Community College.

Institutional Changes:

There have been no major changes since the last reauthorization review.


Recommendation to the Chancellor:

Lindsey Wilson College meets the Chancellor's standards and the staff recommends continued institutional authorization through 2023 to coincide with the college's next accreditation reaffirmation review with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges. Authorization will continue, contingent upon continuing accreditation and compliance with the Chancellor's standards. The Chancellor may, in his judgment, withdraw authorization or require additional review if the college fails to continue to meet the Chancellor's standards for authorization or is sanctioned by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges.


