Malone University

Middle Childhood Generalist Social Studies Endorsement

Request:

Malone University requests approval to offer a baccalaureate level program leading to the Ohio Middle Childhood Generalist Social Studies Endorsement.

Profile:

Malone University is a private, Christian liberal arts university that was founded in 1892 as the Cleveland Bible College. The university has a specific mission to provide students with an education based on biblical faith in order to develop men and women in intellectual maturity, wisdom, and Christian faith who are committed to serving the church, community, and world. Located in Canton, Ohio, the university has an enrollment of more than 1,500 undergraduate students and nearly 400 graduate students.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Malone University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2022. Malone University's educator preparation programs are accredited by National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) until the next review in 2017.

Background:

Malone University is submitting its request to ensure program alignment with Ohio standards and requirements. Programs leading to the Middle Childhood Generalist Social Studies Endorsement are valid for teaching students in grades 4 through 6. Malone University offers the program leading to the Middle Childhood Generalist Social Studies Endorsement at the baccalaureate level.

Recommendation:

Malone University's Middle Childhood Generalist Social Studies Endorsement preparation program meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for baccalaureate level programs leading to the Middle Childhood Generalist Social Studies Endorsement. Approval is recommended for Malone University's baccalaureate level program leading to the Middle Childhood Generalist Social Studies Endorsement until the spring 2024 review cycle. It should be noted that the program is subject to periodic review by the Chancellor to ensure that the standards for Ohio licensure continue to be met.


