### REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

#### Ohio Dominican University

#### Multi-Age Visual Arts License

##### **Request:**

Ohio Dominican University requests approval to offer a post-baccalaureate level program leading to the Ohio Multi-Age Visual Arts License.

##### **Profile:**

Ohio Dominican University is a private, not-for-profit university affiliated with the Catholic church. The university was founded in 1911 as the College of Saint Mary of the Springs. The university has a specific mission to educate all individuals committed to intellectual, spiritual and professional growth to become lifelong learners, committed to serving others in a global society as ethical and effective leaders grounded in the pursuit of truth, justice and peace. Located in Columbus, Ohio, the university has an enrollment of over 1,800 undergraduate and over 800 graduate students.

##### **Accreditation/Authorization:**

Ohio Dominican University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2017. Ohio Dominican University's educator preparation programs are accredited by National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) until the next review in fall 2015.

##### **Background:**

Ohio Dominican University is submitting its request to ensure program alignment with Ohio standards and requirements. Programs leading to the Multi-Age Visual Arts License are valid for teaching students in prekindergarten through grade 12. Ohio Dominican University offers the program leading to the Multi-Age Visual Arts License at the post-baccalaureate level.

##### **Recommendation:**

Ohio Dominican University's Multi-Age Visual Arts License preparation program meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for post-baccalaureate level programs leading to the Multi-Age Visual Arts License. Approval is recommended for Ohio Dominican University's post-baccalaureate level program leading to Multi-Age Visual Arts License until the spring 2022 review cycle. It should be noted that the program is subject to periodic review by the Chancellor to ensure that the standards for Ohio licensure continue to be met.


