Ohio Wesleyan University

Adolescence to Young Adult (7-12) Integrated Mathematics License

Request:

Ohio Wesleyan University requests approval to offer a baccalaureate level program leading to the Ohio Adolescence to Young Adult (7-12) Integrated Mathematics License.

Profile:

Ohio Wesleyan University is a private, not-for-profit national liberal arts and sciences university that was founded in 1844. The university has a specific mission to impart knowledge, develop and enhance certain important capabilities of students, and to place education in the context of values. Located in Delaware, Ohio, the university has an enrollment of more than 1,800 undergraduate students.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Ohio Wesleyan University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2019. Ohio Wesleyan University's educator preparation programs are accredited by National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) until the next review, by the successor organization, Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP), in 2018.

Background:

Ohio Wesleyan University is submitting its request to ensure program alignment with Ohio standards and requirements. Programs leading to the Adolescence to Young Adult (7-12) Integrated Mathematics License are valid for teaching students in grades 7 through 12. Ohio Wesleyan University offers the program leading to the Adolescence to Young Adult (7-12) Integrated Mathematics License at the baccalaureate level.

Recommendation:

Ohio Wesleyan University's Adolescence to Young Adult (7-12) Integrated Mathematics License preparation program meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for baccalaureate level programs leading to the Adolescence to Young Adult (7-12) Integrated Mathematics License. Approval is recommended for Ohio Wesleyan University's baccalaureate level program leading to the Adolescence to Young Adult (7-12) Integrated Mathematics License until the spring 2025 review cycle. The Chancellor may, in his judgement, withdraw approval or require additional review if Ohio Wesleyan University fails to meet the Chancellor's standards for licensure programs or receives a sanction by CAEP. Over the past three reporting years, fewer than ten candidates have completed the program. Due to the small number of completers in the program, the Ohio

Educator Preparation Program Performance Reports could not be considered in the review process to determine acceptable or unacceptable ranges.


