HONDROS COLLEGE

Institutional Reauthorization

Request:

Hondros College requests continued authorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents.

Background:

Hondros College is a private for-profit institution founded in 1981. The college received approval to offer nursing education in 2006 and educates nurses at four Ohio campuses in Fairborn, Independence, West Chester, and Westerville.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Hondros College is accredited by the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools and recognized by the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools. It is also approved by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education.

Program Offerings:

Hondros College offers a diploma program, Associate of Applied Science, and a Bachelor of Science in Nursing . Hondros College is currently undergoing review for a Master of Science in Nursing.

Institutional Changes:

Since its last authorization process, Hondros has expanded its mission from providing education through the baccalaureate level to providing education through the master's level. The Master of Science in Nursing degree is currently undergoing review.

Recommendation to the Chancellor:

Hondros College meets the Chancellor's standards, and the staff recommends continued institutional authorization through December 2016 to coincide with reaccreditation by the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools.
