Sinclair Community College Associate of Applied Science in Electroneurodiagnostic Technology

Request:

Sinclair Community College requests approval to offer an Associate of Applied Science degree in Electroneurodiagnostic Technology.

Background:

Sinclair Community College, located in Dayton, Ohio, is a public college with an enrollment of over 19,000 students and offers more than 100 associate degrees and 122 technical certificates. Sinclair Community College is regionally accredited by the Higher Learning Commission until its next scheduled review in 2017.

Curriculum and Enrollment:

The program was developed in response to the need for electroneurodiagnostic technologists in southwest Ohio. The curriculum is designed to align with the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) and the Committee on Accreditation for Education in Electroneurodiagnostic Technology (CoA-NDT) standards. The curriculum includes coursework in general education, electrocardiography, medical terminology, electroneurodiagnostic technology, and electroencephalography. The culminating experience of the program is a capstone project.

The college is projecting an enrollment of 20 full-time students and 10 part-time students beginning fall 2016 and growing to 50 full-time students within two years.

Faculty and Resources:

The college is financially prepared to offer the program. Existing faculty and resources are in place to begin the program. Additional faculty will be hired to accommodate program growth.

Recommendation:

The program clearly meets the Chancellor's standards for associate degree programs. No concerns were raised during the review.
