REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

University of Toledo

Adolescence to Young Adult Integrated Language Arts License

Request:

University of Toledo requests approval to offer a baccalaureate level program leading to the Ohio Adolescence to Young Adult Integrated Language Arts License.

Profile:

University of Toledo is a public university that was founded in 1872. The university has a specific mission to improve the human condition; to advance knowledge through excellence in learning, discovery and engagement; and to serve as a diverse, student-centered public metropolitan research university. Located in Toledo, Ohio, the university has an enrollment of more than 15,000 undergraduates with over 4,500 graduate students.

Accreditation/Authorization:

University of Toledo is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2022. University of Toledo's educator preparation programs are accredited by National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) until the next review in spring 2016.

Background:

University of Toledo is submitting its request to ensure program alignment with Ohio standards and requirements. Programs leading to the Adolescence to Young Adult Integrated Language Arts License are valid for teaching students in grades 7 through 12. University of Toledo offers the program leading to the Adolescence to Young Adult Integrated Language Arts License at the baccalaureate level.

Recommendation:

University of Toledo's Adolescence to Young Adult Integrated Language Arts License preparation program meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for baccalaureate level programs leading to the Adolescence to Young Adult Integrated Language Arts License. Approval is recommended for University of Toledo's baccalaureate level program leading to the Adolescence to Young Adult Integrated Language Arts License until the spring 2022 review cycle. It should be noted that the program is subject to periodic review by the Chancellor to ensure that the standards for Ohio licensure continue to be met.
