University of Findlay is a private, not-for profit university founded in 1882 with a specific mission to equip our students for meaningful lives and productive careers. Located in Findlay, Ohio, the university has an enrollment of more than 2,600 undergraduate and nearly 1,000 graduate.

Accreditation/Authorization:

University of Findlay is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2014. University of Findlay's educator preparation programs are accredited by National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) until the next review in 2013.



Background:



University of Findlay is submitting its request to ensure program alignment with Ohio standards and requirements. Programs leading to the Multi-Age Visual Arts license are valid for teaching students in . University of Findlay offers the Multi-Age Visual Arts license at the undergraduate and post-baccalaureate level.

Recommendation:

University of Findlay's Multi-Age Visual Arts preparation program meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for undergraduate and post-baccalaureate level programs leading to the Multi-Age Visual Arts license. Approval is recommended for University of Findlay's undergraduate and post-baccalaureate level programs leading to the Multi-Age Visual Arts license until the next national accreditation review. It should be noted that the program is subject to periodic review by the Chancellor to ensure that the standards for Ohio licensure continue to be met.
