REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

University of Dayton

Master of Science in Education--Leadership for Educational Systems

Request:

The University of Dayton requests approval for a new Master of Science in Education--Leadership for Educational Systems degree.

Background:

The University of Dayton is a private nonprofit Catholic university located in Dayton, Ohio. The proposed program is designed primarily for international students to obtain skills and knowledge in the U.S. system of education, enabling them to enhance primary, secondary and higher education systems (P-16) in their own countries. The proposed program also will be available to domestic students wishing to have general knowledge in a wide variety of educational issues.

Curriculum and Enrollment:

The proposed core curriculum will consist of thirty semester credit hours beyond the bachelor's degree. It is comprised of nine existing courses that are being taught in the three contributing academic departments: Educational Leadership (EDA), Counselor Education (EDC) and Teacher Education (EDT), as well as one new course: Scholarly Study in Education. An education research seminar course is required that is the capstone activity of the Master's degree.

Projected enrollment for the program is 20 students in the first year and 40 in the following three years.

Faculty and Resources:

Qualified faculty, adequate facilities and other resources are in place to begin the program. No new or additional faculty or facilities are needed, and there are no increases in costs anticipated for implementation of the proposed program.

Recommendation:

The proposed new Master of Science degree in Education—Leadership for Educational Systems meets the Chancellor's standards for graduate degrees, and the Regents' Advisory Committee on Graduate Study voted to recommend approval to the Chancellor.
