



## REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

### University of Cincinnati

#### Computer Science Endorsement New Program Proposal

**Request:**

University of Cincinnati requests approval to offer a graduate level program leading to the Ohio Computer Science Endorsement. This submission ensures program alignment with Ohio standards and requirements. University of Cincinnati will offer the program leading to the Computer Science Endorsement for grades prekindergarten through grade 12.

**Profile:**

University of Cincinnati is a public university founded 1819. The university has a specific mission to provide undergraduate, graduate, and professional education, experience-based learning, and research. Located in Cincinnati, Ohio, the university has an enrollment of over 33,000 undergraduate and 11,000 graduate and professional students.

**Accreditation/Authorization:**

University of Cincinnati is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2029. University of Cincinnati's educator preparation programs are accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) until the next review in summer 2020.

**Metrics Reported Data** (Per OAC 3333-1-05, data available and reported is limited to initial licensure and principal preparation only): Not required for endorsement programs.

**Recommendation:**

University of Cincinnati's Computer Science preparation program meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for graduate level programs leading to the Computer Science Endorsement. Approval is recommended until the fall 2026 review cycle. The Chancellor may, in his judgement, withdraw approval or require additional review if University of Cincinnati fails to meet the Chancellor's standards for educator preparation programs or receives a sanction by CAEP.
