REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION

WILMINGTON COLLEGE Institutional Reauthorization

Request:

Wilmington College requests continued authorization from the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents.

Profile:

Wilmington College, located in Wilmington, Ohio, is an independent not-for-profit institution affiliated with the Religious Society of Friends (Quaker) founded in 1870 to provide undergraduate and graduate education shaped by the traditions of liberal arts, career preparation, and the distinctive values in the Quaker tradition. The college has an enrollment of approximately 1,300 undergraduate and graduate students.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Wilmington College is regionally accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of the North Central Association until its next review in 2024.

Program Offerings:

Wilmington College offers baccalaureate degrees in 23 areas and one master's degree.

Institutional Changes:

Wilmington College has had changes in the presidency since its last reauthorization. New undergraduate degree programs have been added as well as additional educator preparation programs. Wilmington has revised its general education curriculum and is in the process of developing and implementing an institutional strategic plan and institutional assessment system for student learning.

Recommendation to the Chancellor:

Wilmington College meets the Chancellor's standards and the staff recommends continued institutional authorization through 2024 to coincide with the college's next accreditation reaffirmation review with the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association. The Chancellor may, in his judgment, withdraw authorization or require additional review if the college fails to continue to meet the Chancellor's standards for authorization or is sanctioned by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association.
