TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) Endorsement Program Renewal

Request:

Xavier University requests renewal of authorization to offer a graduate program leading to the TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) Endorsement. This renewal ensures program alignment with Ohio standards and requirements. Programs leading to the TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) Endorsement are valid for teaching in grades K through 12.

Profile:

Xavier University is an independent liberal arts university that provides faith-based education rooted in the Jesuit Catholic tradition that was founded in 1831. The university has a specific mission to educate each student intellectually, morally, and spiritually. Located in Cincinnati, Ohio, the university has an enrollment of more than 6,000 students from the associate degree level to the doctorate degree level.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Xavier University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2021. Xavier University's educator preparation programs are accredited by Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC) until the next review, by the successor organization, Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP), in 2021.

Metrics Reported Data (Per [OAC 3333-1-05](#), data available and reported is limited to initial licensure and principal preparation only): Not required for endorsement programs.

Recommendation:

Xavier University's TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) Endorsement preparation program meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for graduate level programs. Approval is recommended until the fall 2026 review cycle. The Chancellor may, in his judgement, withdraw approval or require additional review if Xavier University fails to meet the Chancellor's standards for educator preparation programs or receives a sanction by CAEP.
