Xavier University

Administrative Specialist: School-Community Relations License

Request:

Xavier University requests approval to offer a graduate level program leading to the Ohio Administrative Specialist: School-Community Relations License.

Profile:

Xavier University is an independent liberal arts university that provides faith-based education rooted in the Jesuit Catholic tradition that was founded in 1831. The university has a specific mission to educate each student intellectually, morally, and spiritually. Located in Cincinnati, Ohio, the university has an enrollment of more than 6,000 students from the associate degree level to the doctorate degree level.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Xavier University is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2021. Xavier University's educator preparation programs are accredited by Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC) until the next review, by the successor organization, Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP), in 2022.

Background:

Xavier University is submitting its request to ensure program alignment with Ohio standards and requirements. Xavier University offers the program leading to the Administrative Specialist: School-Community Relations License at the graduate level.

Recommendation:

Xavier University's Administrative Specialist: School-Community Relations License preparation program meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for graduate level programs leading to the Administrative Specialist: School-Community Relations License. Approval is recommended for Xavier University's graduate level program leading to the Administrative Specialist: School-Community Relations License until the spring 2025 review cycle. The Chancellor may, in his judgement, withdraw approval or require additional review if Xavier University fails to meet the Chancellor's standards for licensure programs or receives a sanction by CAEP.


