What is the Knowledge Base?


The Knowledge Base (KB) is an information repository system that provides a means for information to be collected, organized, shared, searched and utilized. It provides for:

- A secure, reliable platform with authenticated logins
- Threaded discussion area for members (by institution)
- Ability to post documents
- Pinned posts for popular topics
- Ability to subscribe to discussion posts
- Search functionality






