- Eligible students and their families have been notified, counseled and advised regarding College Credit Plus opportunities, benefits and limitations in accordance with Chapter 3365 of the Ohio Revised Code and regulations 3333-1-65.1, 3333-1-65.2 and 3333-1-65.3; and eligible students and families have been informed of and provided access to College Credit Plus resources developed by the state.
- All College Credit Plus courses are taught by qualified instructors pursuant to statute and regulations, follow the same syllabus, use the same text book and materials, set learning aspirations to achieve the same learning outcomes and use the same assessments methods as the college course delivered on the college campus. All students participating in a College Credit Plus course, whether for receipt of college credit or high school only credit, are required to adhere to the college course standards and are in receipt of all notices and benefits required pursuant to statute and regulations.
- Both parties to this request understand that the terms of this or any other Alternative Funding Agreement shall not limit student choice of postsecondary institution enrollment, course selection or course registration under College Credit Plus.
- Both parties to this request for approval of credit hour payment below the floor agree that all statutory and administrative requirements of this Chapter of the Ohio Revised Code have been met.

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Nonpublic postsecondary president affirms the following:

We acknowledge that if the terms of our agreement with a district require students who are not considered to be economically disadvantaged to incur any charge as a result of the student choosing to enroll at our institution under College Credit Plus, then students and parents will be informed of the terms and such terms will be or are noted in our student admission application and accessible to students and parents on-demand.
