Senate Bill 120	Conduct performance audits of state higher ed institutions	Amendment added in the House Higher Education committee that would require each public high school and participating private high school to permit a university or college that participates in the College Credit Plus (CCP) program and is located within 30 miles of the school, or the next closest one if none are within that distance, to attend annual informational sessions about CCP if the university or college requests to attend.	3/26/19: Introduced in the Senate 5/1/19: Passed the Senate 10/25/19: Passed the House Higher Education Committee with an amendment re: CCP . House Bill 166	State Operating Budget FY 20 & 21	<p>Foundation Formula Amount (Sec. 265.215): The formula amount for FY 2020 and FY 2021 equals the formula amount for FY 2019 (\$6,020).</p> <p>High School Graduation Requirements: Includes some CCP-related issues in the new graduation requirements provisions.</p> <p>Teacher Credentialing Grant (Sec. 265.120): Provides up to \$3,000,000 in FY 2020 for grants for high school teachers to receive credentialing to teach College Credit Plus courses at the high school.</p> <p>Nonpublic Student Funding (Sec. 265.170): Earmarks up to \$2,600,000 each year for nonpublic school students.</p> <p>Homeschooled Student Funding (Sec. 265.210): Provides up to \$2,000,000 in each fiscal year for home-instructed students.</p>	<p>7/17/19: Bill passed by both House and Senate.</p> <p>7/18/19: Signed by the Governor, with several vetoes.
