

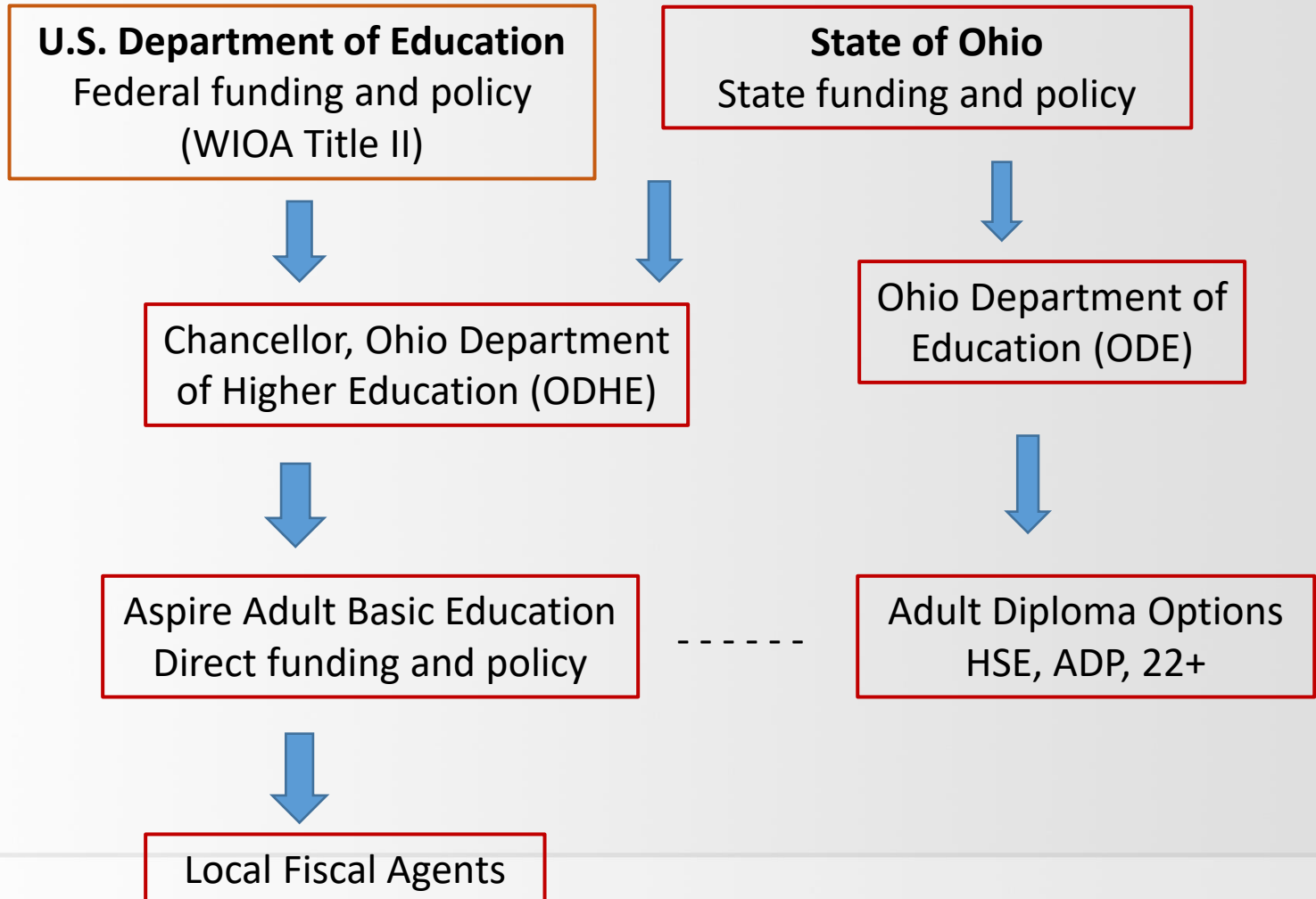

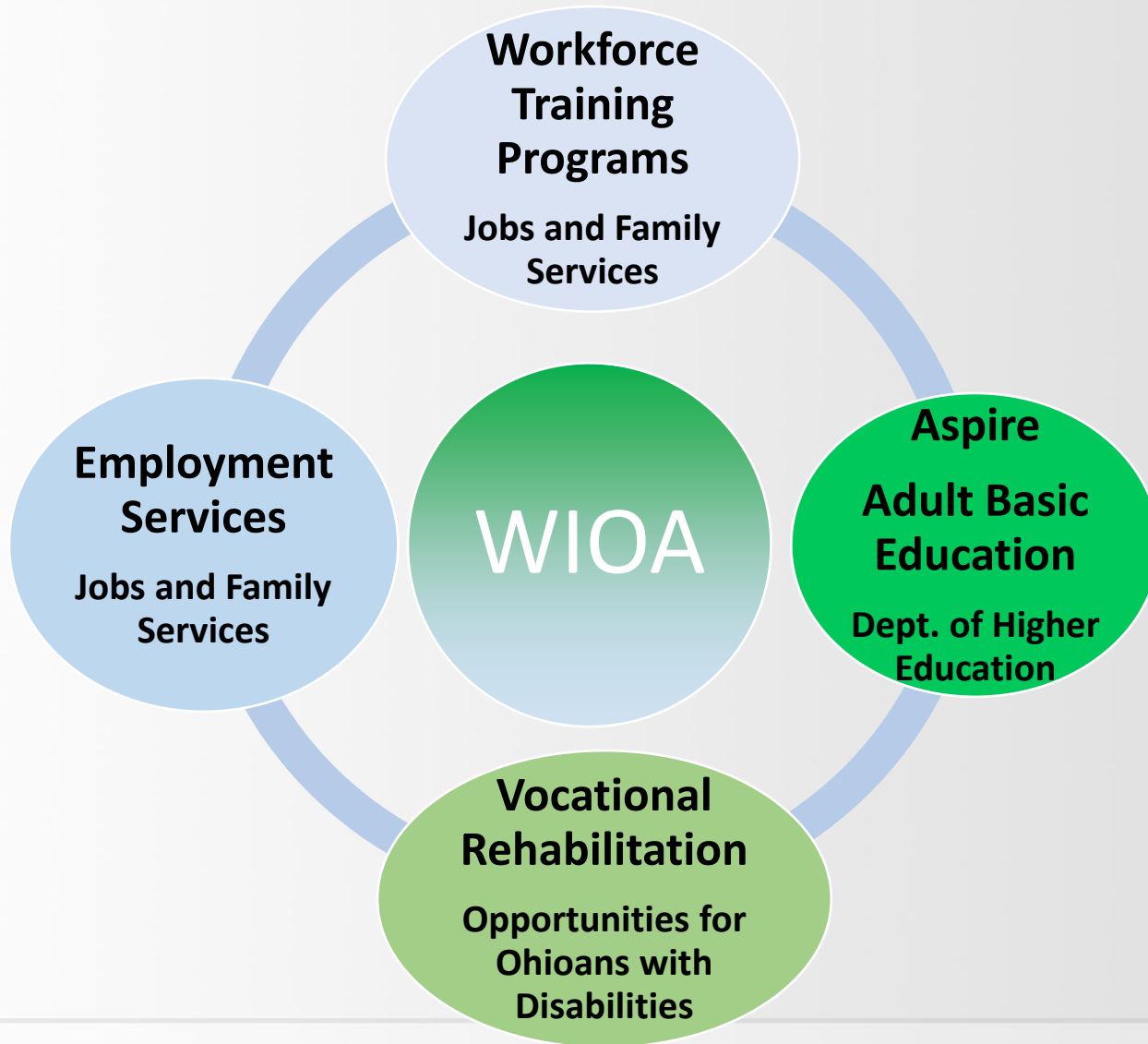

# Adult Education and Family Literacy Act

- *Assist adults to become literate and obtain the knowledge and **skills necessary for employment and economic self-sufficiency***
- *Assist adults who are parents or family members become a **full partner in the education development of their children***
- *Assist adults in **completing high school***
- *Promote transitions from **adult education to postsecondary education and training through career pathways***

*American Community Survey, 2011-2015, 5-year estimate*

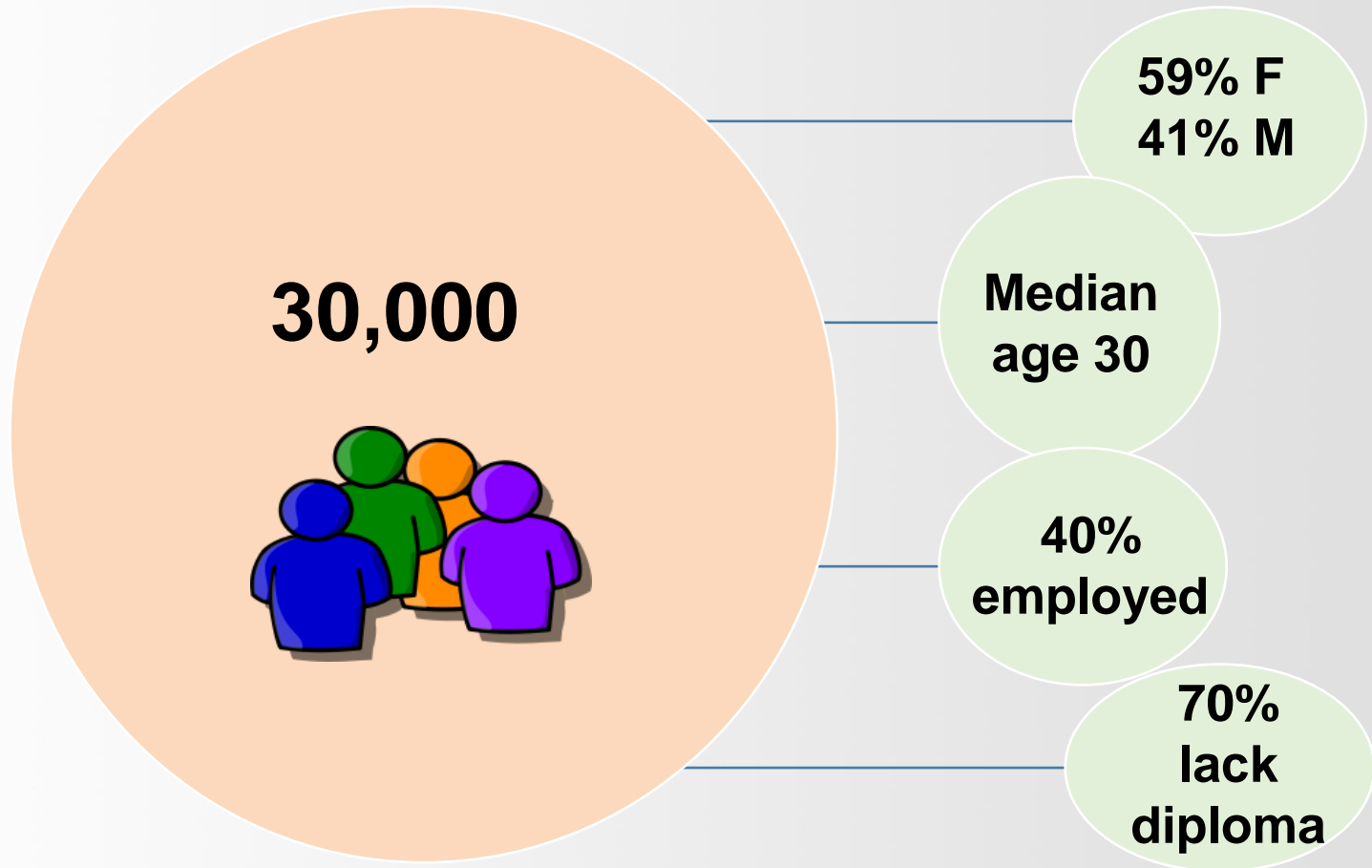
**76,000** Ohioans age 18 - 64 speak English “Less than Very Well”

**58%** of Ohio community college students place into remedial coursework

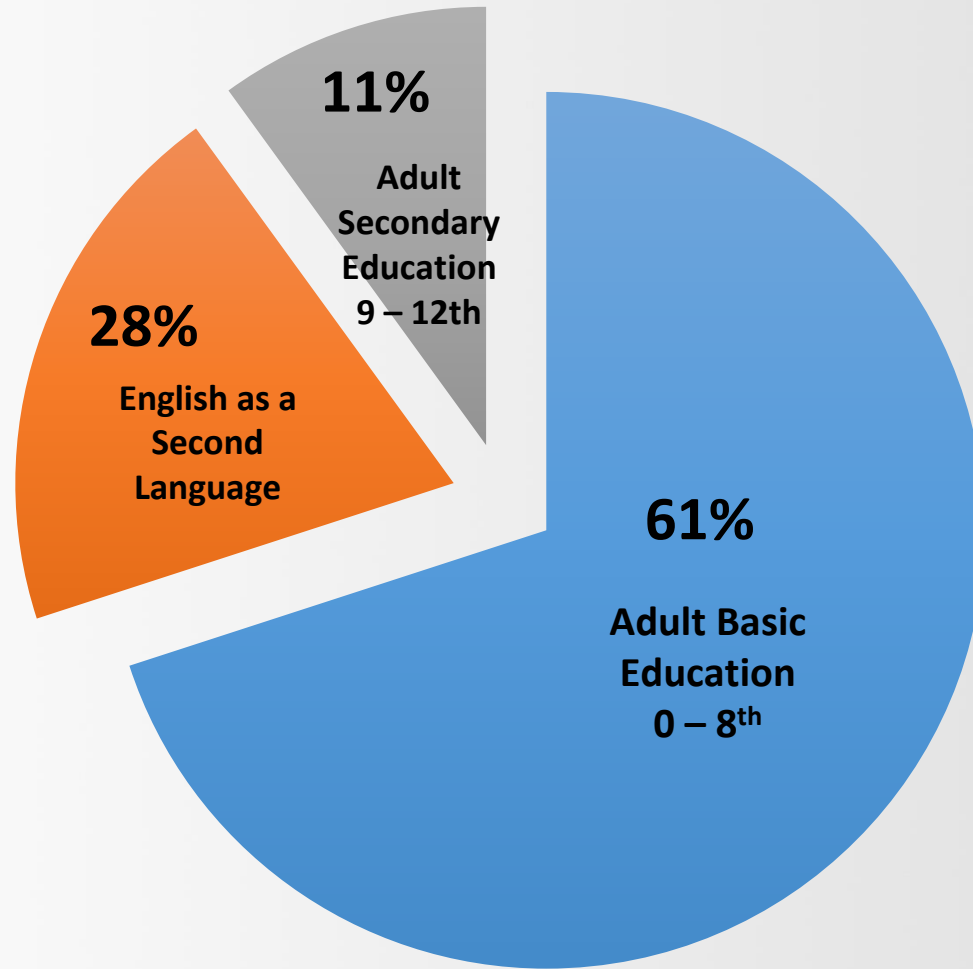
