Gateway Mathematics courses: Questions and answers

Degree-seeking college students must successfully complete a *Gateway Mathematics* course – the beginning credit bearing Mathematics course – as a part of their degree completion requirements.

Specific questions for baseline information

- How many students attending Ohio public institutions of higher education attempt Gateway Mathematics courses in an academic year?
- How many gateway courses are attempted by them?
- What is the average number of gateway courses attempted per student?
- What are the completion rates in gateway courses?
- Do completion rates differ by campus-type (across groups of two-year, four-year regional, four-year main, etc.)?
- Do completion rates differ across institutions of the same type (within groups of two-year, four-year regional, four-year main etc.)?
- What are the common Gateway Mathematics courses?

Data

- The questions are answered using data from the Higher Education Information (HEI) system of the Ohio Department of Higher Education.
- Gateway courses were identified as part of the Strong Start to Finish grant reporting requirements
- The data are from academic year 2017-18.
- Because institutions assign Gateway courses to their students, identification of Gateway English courses at the institutions is a necessary step to preparing the report. Such information was available for 15 two-year institutions, and eight four-year universities – eight four-year university main campuses, and the nine affiliated four-year regional campuses.

Institutions with identified Gateway Mathematics courses

- **Two-year institutions (15):** Clark State Community College, Cincinnati State Community & Technical College, Central Ohio Technical College, Columbus State Community College, Edison State Community College, Hocking College, Lorain County Community College, Marion Technical College, North Central State College, Owens Community College, Sinclair Community College, Southern State Community College, Stark State College of Technology, Terra State Community college and Washington State Community College.
- **Four-year university regional campuses (9):** Miami University – Hamilton campus, Miami University – Middletown campus, Ohio State University – AGTI campus, Ohio State University – Lima campus, Ohio State University – Marion campus, Ohio State University – Mansfield campus, Ohio State University – Newark campus, University of Cincinnati – Clermont campus, University of Cincinnati – Blue Ash campus.
- **Four-year university main campuses (8):** Bowling Green State University, University of Cincinnati, Cleveland State University, Miami University, Ohio State University, Shawnee State University, University of Toledo, Wright State University.

Findings

- 65,117 students attempted 76,343 Gateway Mathematics courses, 1.17 courses per person on average.
- Four-year university main campuses and two-year institutions accounted for 44.8% 43.1%, respectively, of enrollments. Four-year regional campuses accounted for 12.1% of enrollment.
- Average course completion rates were 75.2%.
- Completion rates were the highest at four-year main campuses (80.9%), followed by four-year regional campuses (79.8%), and two-year institutions (68.0%).
- Among two-year institutions, completion rates were higher for smaller Gateway Course enrollment. Among four-year main campuses, higher quality institutions had higher completion rates.

What did we learn?

- Almost identical numbers of two-year and four-year main campus students – 32,892 and 34,194, respectively – took Gateway Mathematics courses in 2017-18.
- Completion rates in Gateway Mathematics courses were the highest for four-year main campus students (80.9%), followed by students from four-year regional campuses (79.8%), and two-year institutions (68.0%), respectively.
- Statistics was the most common Gateway Mathematics courses with a share of 27.7%, followed closely by Calculus (26.7%). Algebra had a share of 22.9%, while Quantitative Reasoning had a share of only 7.4%.
- Completion rates, however, were the highest for Statistics (80.3%), followed by Statistics (76.9%), and Calculus (76.9%).
- Relative to completion rates in all courses taken by students in 2017-18, average completion rates in Gateway Mathematics courses were approximately 10 points lower.
