The following table outlines how transfer credits will be applied to either the Bachelor of Arts in Social Work (BAT) or Bachelor of Arts with a major in Social Work at the University of Akron for students who completed an Associate of Arts degree via the Ohio Guaranteed Social Work Transfer Pathway. The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting business programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.
