This Associate of Science pathway in Anthropology is intended for students who would like to pursue a Bachelor of Science in Anthropology/Anthropological Sciences. Columbus State Community College also offers an Associate of Arts with a pathway in Anthropology for students interested in a Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology. Students should work closely with their academic advisor to determine the appropriate course of study based on interests, career goals, and intended receiving institution.
