

The following table outlines how transfer credits will be applied to the Bachelor of Arts in Political Science degree at Kent State University for students who completed an Associate of Arts or degree via the Ohio Guaranteed Political Science Transfer Pathway. The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.
