These can often be fulfilled as part of the associate degree with careful course selection. Please work with your advisor to identify appropriate courses. <sup>2</sup> Kent State requires that students successfully complete a minimum of 39 upper-division credit hours. <sup>3</sup> Kent State requires a total of 120 credits hours for bachelor's degree completion. The total number of hours to complete the bachelor's degree represents a range of hours that may be needed depending on the individual course selections made during the associate degree program.
