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The new Ohio Transfer 36 provides a broad framework for which general education coursework will transfer. Furthermore, it begins to differentiate between how general education course selections might look different for students interested in pursuing an Associate of Arts/Bachelor of Arts or an Associate of Science/Bachelor of Science.

The work of the Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathways (OGTP) goes hand in hand with the new Ohio Transfer 36. Using the new Ohio Transfer 36 framework, the OGTP faculty panels have developed pathways that provide more specific guidance for students in choosing transferable general education coursework based on their academic interests in a given cluster area (e.g., Social & Behavioral Sciences, Humanities, Math & Sciences, etc.).

Further if a student knows what they plan to major in, they can utilize the OGTP for that particular major, which will provide the most precise guidance on any specific transferable general education coursework that they should take in order to best progress within their chosen major.
