

## Admissions & Registrar's Meeting – April 24 2014 – Questions and Action items

### **E-Transcript Update**

- Will there be a move to have a common High School transcript?
  - Answer: The answer is complex, because the Ohio is a local control state. Those in electronic format will have similar data elements that will appear standard
- The project is free now, what happens at the end of the grant period?
  - Answer: The Dept of Education is working toward subsidizing for FY' 15, after that point there will be a fee of approximately \$2.95 per transcript. Keep in mind that there will be the option to have the fee waived for low income students
- Is there a plan to automate the transcript receive process into the SIS to include evaluation?
  - Answer: Parchment is similar to the ATC, in that the transcript is delivered as sent. If the SIS supports evaluation, then it could happen depending on the institutions' process. As far as transcripts delivered, transcripts will have an "inbox" letting users know transcripts are available to be downloaded.
- How would transfer students work?
  - Answer: Student would have to request to have their transcripts sent again.
  - For transfer students, original high school transcript is needed. Students can send in a high school transcript
- There are concerns that e-Transcript can be confusing unless all schools participate. There may be a need to organize various constituents before the end of the next fiscal year.
- High school can sign up to send unlimited number of transcript.

### **Career Technical Presentation**

- A question was brought up about HEI reporting. How to code the credit to HEI?
  - Answer: We will follow up since there was not an HEI representative present at the meeting
- Is the website live for the Career-Technical information (verification form update)
  - Answer: The main Career-Technical website (<https://ohiohighered.org/transfer/ct2>) will have that information in two weeks.

### **Ohio Technical Centers (Adult workforce education) Presentation**

- Any difficulties in higher education institutions receiving what they need from adult centers (OTC's) now?
  - Answer: Currently they do not get that many transcripts, not seemingly an issue at this point.
- Has there been a vote on CETE assessments as yet?
  - Answer: Not as yet.

- Use of the CETE exam as a validation for college credit awarding
  - CETE scores – electronic version of the test score to SIS would be nice.
  - Education portfolio comes in paper right now.

### CollegeSource & TES

- CollegeSource was asked about the waiting period for technical support assistance. How long?
  - Answer: CollegeSource has been backed up as of late, however the issues are being reviewed. Typically help can be expected within 24 hours

- Are we making sure that students are aware of any negative consequences for getting their Associate degrees with Reverse Transfer?
  - Answer: One potential impact is financial aid related. This may be if a student attempts to receive a 3<sup>rd</sup> Associate degree. Another concern is with the student's program of study. More research needs to be conducted to explore negative consequences.

### ATC Updates Presentation

- Is there an option to turn email notifications on for errors (rejected transcripts)?
  - Answer: OATN will look into this to consider what the options are for email notifications and for the length of time notifications are sent. Currently the reporting system is available and should be used to show what transcripts were not sent due to errors in data validation
- Can we have a report to see how many transcripts have been rejected?
  - Answer: Our development team will be asked to generate a report, more information to come when this report is made available.
