

ATC Steering Committee Meeting – March 4 2014

E-Transcript Update

- Ohio Department of Education (ODE) provided updates about the status of the project. Pilot ITC's are coming online over the next three months; making it possible to start live testing between Parchment and Higher Ed SIS systems.
- ODE will provide additional funding if the federal dollars expire at the end of June.
- The forecast is to have the pilot testing and grant recipient bridge to their SIS built by December 2014.

Admissions & Registrar Meeting in April

- Agenda was revised and suggestions were brought up for the meeting.
- Members suggested that no break-out sessions be held and for the meeting to focus on providing information to all attendees.
- Committee members provided feedback on items to be added to the agenda.

OATN Initiative Updates

- The ATC Validation Project
- Going Paperless is almost at fruition, with just one college nearing completion of being connected to the ATC.
- Committee members agreed to the terms of Transcript Removal.
- Members also inquired about a way for institutions to track the latest OBR initiatives. The purpose would be to get an idea of each initiative and status.

ATC Transcript Supplement

- Committee members reviewed the summary presented by Revathi Kumaraswamy and provided feedback.
- The members agreed that transfer tables should be kept up to date to ensure accuracy of awarding credit.
- Suggestion was given that smaller institutions could have one TA system to pool limited resources together.
- Another suggestion was to formulate a process & pathway for automating the process of maintaining TA tables. A group could be commissioned along with CIO involvement to align resources.

Reverse Transfer & One Year Option

- Committee members asked about participation and the continuation of the initiative after the grant period ends.

- Calista Smith indicated that that ways to continue the process are being reviewed, as the idea is to have CWID a part of the Registrar's regular workflow.
- Monthly meetings continue to be held for CWID to assist schools with participation and information.

CollegeSource & TES

- CollegeSource rolls out Transferology at the end of March, and committee members were reminded to test the new system before it is live.
- OBR is following up with institutions that have not participated in the BETA testing
- Members mentioned that a statewide license for TES could be considered for colleges and universities

ATC Future Initiatives

- OATN will continue to evaluate the effort needed to add graduate transcripts to the ATC
- Ohio Technical Centers will also be evaluated to determine if electronic transcripts can be sent through the ATC.

- At the April 24th meeting, we will have a short presentation on how USO institutions can track OBR Initiatives.
