

Aspire June Updates

APR Data Pull Date Moved Forward Slightly

As mentioned at the fall regional meetings, we will be moving the final data pull date for the APR from August 15 to August 10, 2018. To assist programs with ensuring accurate collection of programmatic information, a preliminary data pull will occur on July 6, 2018, so that state staff can begin combing through the information to isolate gaps in data and to help data entry specialists in eliminating entry errors, as well as verifying student achievements. Once the preliminary data pull occurs, programs can expect to hear from their program manager or a member of the OLRC staff to help go over potential gaps in data or to hear the “all clear, great job” report. In future program years, final data pulls for the APR will be conducted on July 31. That means this year’s APR data pull will occur on August 10, 2018, but FY19’s data pull will occur on July 31, 2019. If you have questions, please contact your program manager.

Office of Opportunities for New Americans

Earlier this month, Ohio Governor John R. Kasich used an executive order to create the Office of Opportunities for New Americans and the New Americans Advisory Committee. These entities will provide guidance and services to help integrate immigrants into the workforce and their communities through assistance with job searching, training, and business development. FY 2019 SOFTWARE

The state Aspire office is planning to purchase statewide seats in July for Burlington English and Edmentum Plato. There is a limit on the number of seats available per program based on last year's usage. Burlington English (BE) is designed to be a classroom tool and is best suited if every student in the class has access to the software if the teacher is using BE lessons.
