The Ohio Department of Higher Education, in collaboration with the Ohio Department of Education, created the advising tools included with this letter to assist teachers and students in navigating the adult high school diploma options available in Ohio. The Adult Diploma Options include:

- Adult Diploma Program (ADP)
- 22+ High School Diploma
- High School Equivalence (HSE)

The HSE option is the most readily available throughout Ohio. It is the responsibility of the local education provider to know which options are available in the community before referring students. For more details about these options, visit

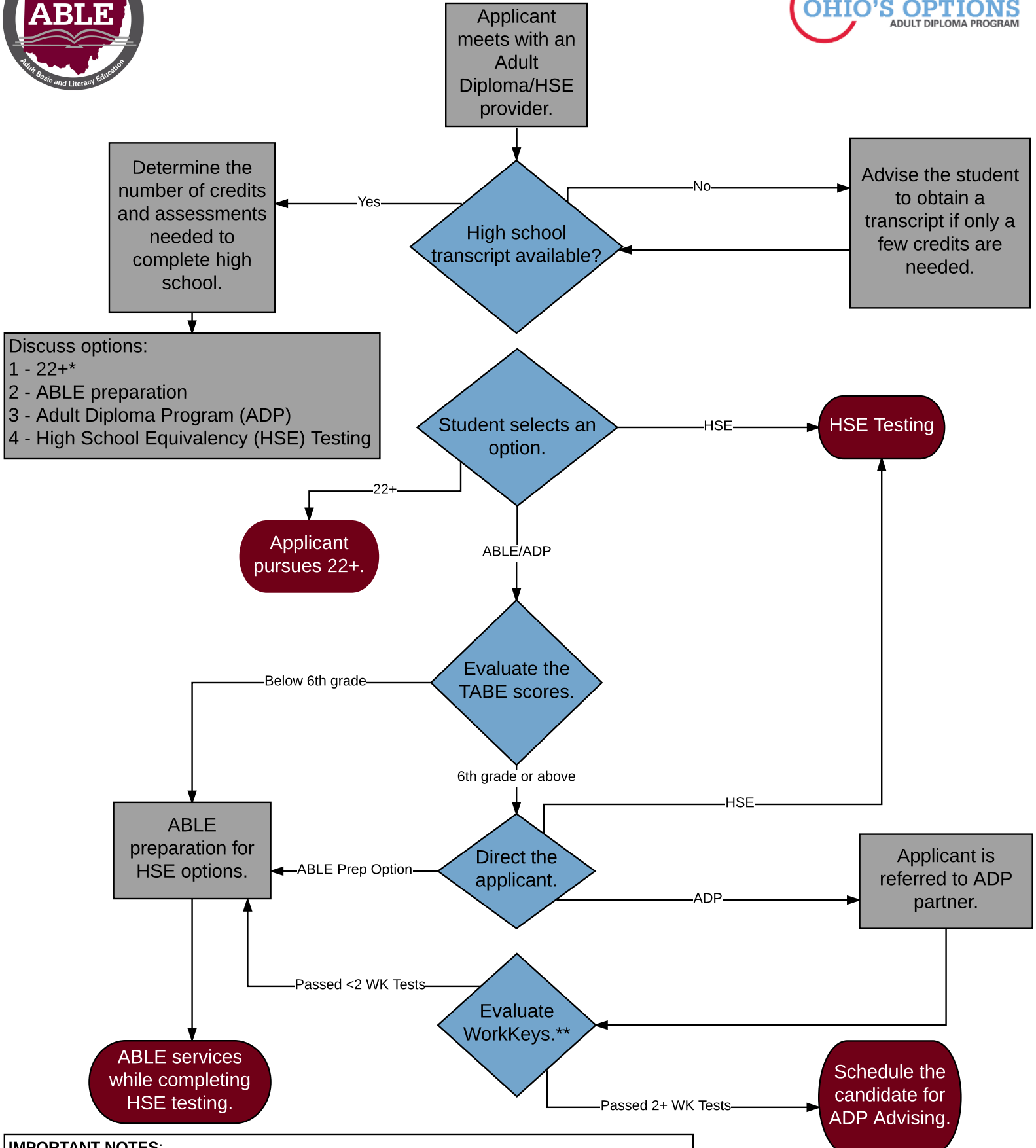
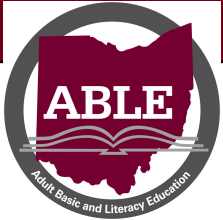

 \*Student must need less than a combination of 8 credits and/or assessments to pursue 22+. 8 credits and assessments is a beginning of the year guideline. The amount of credits/assessments will decrease as courses and assessments should be completed by June 30.
