Data Considerations

1. Public university data may have contained students from both main and regional campuses.
2. Response scales for the benchmark questions varied slightly for some institutions, and any questions with substantively different response scales were excluded from the aggregate analyses.
3. Edison State Community College had no student responses for the benchmark questions.
4. Wilmington College's data could not be disaggregated into individual responses and were therefore not included with the aggregated private college or statewide data.
5. The University of Rio Grande and Rio Grande Community College represent a unique partnership between a private and public institution of higher education. Students attending these institutions share staff, faculty, and facilities across a single campus. Due to this unique campus arrangement, surveys were collected from students attending each respective institution, combined as a single summary under the University of Rio Grande & Rio Grande Community College, and aggregated with the private colleges surveyed.
