Students attending more than one campus of those institutions are counted only once. This is a change from prior reporting practices, which will cause differences between the enrollment numbers in this report compared to those in reports published in prior years.

▪ Enrollments at universities with regional campuses (University of Akron, Bowling Green State University, University of Cincinnati, Kent State University, Miami University, Ohio University, Ohio State University, and Wright State University) are reported at the campus level. Students attending multiple campuses in the same term are counted once at each campus.
