

# First to Second Year Retention at Ohio's Public and Private Colleges and Universities

Fall 2008 to Fall 2013 Cohorts of First-Time, Full-Time, Degree-Seeking Undergraduates

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
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## First-to-Second-Year Retention

### First-Time, Full-Time, Degree-Seeking Freshmen in Fall 2013 Persisting to Fall 2014



- First-to-second-year retention rates vary by type of institution. This reflects the varying levels of academic preparation of incoming students as well as the diverse missions of Ohio's campuses. At public institutions, 70% of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking freshmen returned to the same institution in their second year. An additional 7% transferred to another institution in Ohio, resulting in a statewide retention rate of 77%.
- Retention rates at Ohio's public universities vary depending on the selectivity of admissions. Open-admissions universities had a 75% statewide retention rate, compared to 90% at selective-admissions universities.
- The statewide retention rate at community colleges was 56%. University regional campuses had a higher retention rate of 68%, which is reflective of the transfer missions associated with these campuses.
- At Ohio's private, not-for-profit institutions 74% of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking freshmen returned to the same institution the following year.

Groups and Outcomes	Definitions
<b>Selective Admission University Main Campuses</b>	The following main campuses adhere to selective admissions: Bowling Green State University, University of Cincinnati, Kent State University, Miami University, Ohio University, and Ohio State University
<b>Open Admission University Main Campuses</b>	Open Admission universities include the University of Akron, Central State University, Cleveland State University, Shawnee State University, the University of Toledo, Wright State University, and Youngstown State University.
<b>First-time, Full-time Degree-seeking Students</b>	The Students in this cohort must fulfill three criteria: 1)the Students must be first-time ever in college in the fall term, enrolled in 12 or more hours in the fall term, and must be degree-seeking. Degree-seeking includes all university students, as well as those students who plan to obtain an associate for transfer at the community college level. The cohort may include students whose first term of enrollment is summer, if they continue their enrollment in fall. Data is gathered from the student entrance (SE) and student enrollment (SN) files submitted to the Board of Regents. For private institutions, the cohort data are taken from IPEDS.
<b>First-Year Students</b>	When an undergraduate student has begun their college course-taking, they are submitted by the institution as 'first-time ever in college' within the Student Entrance File. High school students who have taken college courses graduate from high school and begin attending college as regular college students, are still marked as 'first-time ever.'
<b>Full-Time (Undergraduate)</b>	An undergraduate student enrolled in 12 or more hours in the beginning fall term is considered full-time. Developmental course credits are included in the credit total.
<b>Part-Time (Undergraduate)</b>	A student enrolled in less than 12 hours in the beginning fall term is considered part-time. Developmental course credits are included in the credit total.
<b>Persisting at Same Institution</b>	Of the first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students, the number that are enrolled in courses at the same institution in the fall term of the following year as collected from the student enrollment (SN) file from HEI.
<b>Persisting at Any Institution</b>	Of the first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students, the number that are enrolled in courses at any Ohio Public Institution in the fall term of the following year.
