Definitions

Any Aid

Percent of first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who received any financial aid. Financial aid includes grants, loans, assistantships, scholarships, fellowships, tuition waivers, tuition discounts, veteran's benefits, employer aid (tuition reimbursement) and other monies (other than from relatives/friends) provided to students to meet expenses. This includes Title IV subsidized and unsubsidized loans made directly to students.

Any Grant

Percent of first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who received any grant aid (grants/educational assistance funds). Any grant aid includes federal, state and local government grants and institutional grants.

Federal Grants

Percent of first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who received federal grants (grants/educational assistance funds). Includes grants provided by federal agencies such as the U.S. Department of Education, including Title IV Pell Grants and Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (SEOG). Also includes need-based and merit-based educational assistance funds and training vouchers provided from other federal agencies and/or federally-sponsored educational benefits programs, including the Veteran's Administration, Department of Labor, and other federal agencies.

State Grants

Percent of first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who received state/local grants (grants/scholarships/waivers). Includes state and local monies awarded to the institution under state and local student aid programs, including the state portion of State Student Incentives Grants (SSIG).

Institution Grants

Percent of first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who received institutional grants (scholarships/fellowships). Includes scholarships and fellowships granted and funded by the institution and/or individual departments within the institution, (i.e., instruction, research, public service) that may contribute indirectly to the enhancement of these programs. Includes scholarships targeted to certain individuals (e.g., based on state of residence, major field of study, athletic team participation) for which the institution designates the recipient.

Loans

Percent of first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who received student loans. Includes any monies that must be repaid to the lending institution for which the student is the designated borrower. Includes all Title IV subsidized and unsubsidized loans and all institutionally- and privately-sponsored loans. Does not include PLUS and other loans made directly to parents.
