<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teacher Leader Endorsement programs must only be offered at the graduate (post-master's) level, however they are not required to be embedded within a doctoral program.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ OBR approval for existing undergraduate or master's level Teacher Leader Endorsement programs will expire on September 15, 2013. Institutions submit a program Dormancy Form to OBR by September 15, 2013 and include names of all students that may seek licensure.</li> <li>○ Students currently enrolled in an approved undergraduate or master's level Teacher Leader Endorsement program may continue, however they must complete the program by June 15, 2014.</li> <li>○ Institutions not currently holding OBR approval of a graduate (post-master's) level Teacher Leader Endorsement program may not admit new Teacher Leader Endorsement students in Spring 2013, Summer 2013 or Fall 2013.</li> <li>○ Institutions not currently holding OBR approval of a graduate (post-master's) level program that plan to seek Teacher Leader Endorsement program approval for student enrollment beginning in Spring 2014 must submit program proposals to the OBR by September 15, 2013.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Teacher Leader Endorsement programs must have a minimum of nine and a maximum of 12 credit hours</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Current Ohio educator license</li> <li>• Master's degree completion</li> <li>• Four years of successful teaching experience as demonstrated by evaluations and student growth measures               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Applicants are required to provide evidence stipulated.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Institutions are responsible to provide OBR assurance that candidate entrance requirements are met.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Demonstrate knowledge, skills and dispositions at the distinguished level, as described in the <a href="#">Ohio Standards for the Teaching Profession (OSTP)</a></li> <li>• Perform at distinguished level as described in <a href="#">OSTP</a></li> <li>• Achieve assessment results at or above institutionally-established threshold scores on multiple performance-based assessments throughout program</li> </ul>
