

Authorization for the Release of Educational Records to Stark State College

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) as amended is a federal law that protects the privacy of a student's educational records.

Under FERPA regulations, Directory Information, such as address/telephone number, is the information that may be released without a student's consent. Disclosure of non-directory information, however, requires written permission to release to those beyond Clark State Community College. This form allows you to give the required written permission to release your educational records to Stark State College. Educational records include but are not limited to transcripts, GPA, grades, academic course performance and progression records.

By signing the form below, you are giving Clark State Community College permission to release your confidential academic information to Stark State College. If you do not want this information released, leave the signature line blank.
