Subject: Ohio Math Summit Sponsored by The Ohio State University, the Ohio Association of

You are invited to send a team of faculty from your institution to the Ohio Math Summit on May 8, 2013 from 9:30am-3:00pm. Administrators who focus on curricular matters (deans/associate deans, department/division chairs) are also invited. The Ohio State University and the Ohio Association of Community Colleges, along with the Ohio Articulation and Transfer Network, will be hosting the summit at the Blackwell Inn on The Ohio State University Columbus Campus.

The purpose of the summit is to discuss and learn about topics related to Ohio Transfer Module Mathematics, Statistics, and Logic prerequisites and effective quantitative pathways for STEM and non-STEM majors. With the release of the <u>Uniform Statewide Standards for Remediation-Free Status</u> and <u>Ohio College Readiness Expectations</u> in mathematics, many institutions are now exploring new options for credit-bearing college-level courses. These changes led to a recommendation that a statewide discussion occur. The keynote speaker for the Ohio Math Summit will be Dr. Uri Treisman, Professor of Mathematics and of Public Affairs at The University of Texas at Austin. He is the founder and Executive Director of the University's Charles A. Dana Center, an organized research unit of the College of Natural Sciences. The summit will be facilitated by Dr. W. Randy Smith, Vice Provost for Academic Programs at The Ohio State University and Ms. Cathy Chudzinski, Professor of Biology at Terra Community College, who are the Co-Chairs of the OTM Faculty Sub-Committee; and Dr. Treisman.
