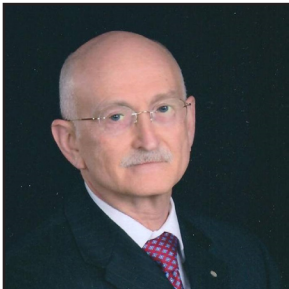

Jean Chappell is the Dean of Health and Public Safety at Cincinnati State Technical and Community College, where she also sits on the advisory board for several community agencies aimed at improving healthcare education and/or meeting the workforce needs of our diverse community. Her areas of interest include those involving workforce diversity and the application of prior learning for degree completion. In addition she serves on the statewide Military Strategic Implementation Team for the Ohio Board of Regents.



Joe Law is Assistant Vice President for Articulation and Transfer and Professor of English at Wright State University, where he also directs the Writing Across the Curriculum program and the Wright State Core (WSU's general education program). In addition, he is a member of the Ohio Articulation and Transfer Network Oversight Board and a consulting member of the Military Strategic Implementation Team for the Ohio Board of Regents.



Jared Shank serves as Transfer Articulation Coordinator at Wright State University. In this role he made WSU the first Ohio school to post military equivalencies into transfer.org, now Transferology. His work also allowed WSU to become the first Ohio public institution to utilize the ACE Veteran Friendly Toolkit. He is currently the lead on the statewide military strategic implementation team to create a new MTAG for military credit.
